



ROAD WORKS NOTIFICATION

27 April – 30 April

The Public Transport Project Alliance (PTPA) will be undertaking asphalt works along King William Street, between South Terrace and Gouger Street/Angas Street, as part of the City South Tram Line Replacement Project.

These works will be undertaken during the day, commencing **Monday, 27 April** to **Thursday, 30 April**, between the hours of **7am-5pm daily**, weather permitting.

Works will be undertaken as follows:

- **27 April – 28 April** northbound works between South Terrace and Angas Street/Gouger Street.
- **29 April – 30 April** southbound works between Angas Street/Gouger Street and South Terrace.

To safely undertake these works, traffic management will be in place during the works, with one lane open to traffic in the direction of works along King William Street at all times.

East/west traffic movements crossing King William Street may experience some restrictions, when works are occurring within an intersection. All vehicles will be guided by traffic management to safely cross King William Street.

There will be temporary parking restrictions in place directly surrounding the works.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to local residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

There will be no impacts to pedestrians during these works and access will be maintained along both sides of King William Street. Pedestrians are reminded to keep clear of the work zones, however traffic management will be in place throughout these works to assist with pedestrian and cyclist movements.

Public Transport

There will be no impact to the tram services during these works, however there will be some impacts to bus services using stops between South Terrace and Angus Street/Gouger Street, with these stops being temporarily closed for the duration of the works.
