



MEYER ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WORKS NOTIFICATION – JULY 2020

END OF WORKS

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI), through the Public Transport Projects Alliance (PTPA) is delivering the Meyer Road Bridge Replacement Project at Lonsdale.

Jointly funded by the Australian Government's Bridge Renewal Program, the City of Onkaparinga Council and DPTI, the Meyer Road Bridge provides a key connection between local industry, surrounding suburbs and road networks and spans over the Seaford to Adelaide passenger rail line.

Work on the Meyer Road Bridge commenced in February 2020, and construction is on schedule for completion by early July 2020, weather permitting.

The works have included:

- demolishing and removing the majority of the existing bridge structure;
- relocation of services onto their own independent structure;
- building and installing new bridge structure;
- installation of bridge barriers and protection screens;
- installation of stormwater works; and
- construction of road works that tie into the bridge structure.

The Meyer Road Bridge will reopen to traffic in both directions in early July 2020, weather permitting. Signage will continue to be in place to alert road users to the changed traffic conditions.

We would like to thank all stakeholders for their patience and cooperation whilst these important works were undertaken.
