

Project overview

MIKE TURTUR BIKEWAY OVERPASS PROJECT

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$25 million for the design and construction of the Mike Turtur Bikeway Overpass Project.

The Mike Turtur Bikeway Overpass Project involves the construction of a Shared Use Path over the rail corridor at Goodwood to improve connectivity and safety for pedestrians and cyclists.

The concept design also includes:

- elevators from the overpass onto the Goodwood Railway Station platform to provide Disability Discrimination Act 1992 compliant access;
- Disability Discrimination Act 1992 compliant ramps on the east (on Railway Terrace North) and west (in Forestville Reserve parallel to the tram overpass);
- relocating the netball ring/basketball key west of the current location;
- installing and upgrading the Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) for the overpass ramps, elevator areas and underpass; and
- installation and upgrades to lighting to the ramps, adjacent footpaths and lift areas.

Construction works will begin in 2022, with completion expected in 2023, weather permitting.
