OVINGHAM LEVEL CROSSING REMOVAL PROJECT

COMMON SERVICES TRENCH WORKS

SEPTEMBER 2021

As part of the Ovingham Level Crossing Removal Project, a Common Services Trench (CST) is being installed. The CST will hold key utility services including lighting, communications and power. It will be located along Torrens Road, between West Street and Gilbert Street, and at the Torrens Road junction.

Installation of the CST commenced in August 2021 and will continue until early 2022. The CST works include trenching within the road, installation of conduits, utility services and light pole footings, and placement of asphalt. Underground stormwater drainage systems will also be installed within the project construction area and on the eastern side of the railway line, alongside Torrens Road and Churchill Road.

To safely facilitate these works across Torrens Road and Churchill Road, road closures and traffic detours will be required while this work is carried out.

To minimise the impact to road users, night works will be undertaken **in mid-September 2021, between 7pm and 6am**, weather permitting.

What to expect during night works

Traffic changes

To safely facilitate these works, the following changed traffic conditions will be in place while the work is carried out:

- northbound and southbound lanes of Churchill Road, between Avenue Road and Torrens Road, will be closed from the **14 - 16 September 2021, between 7pm and 6am, weather permitting.**
- eastbound lanes of Torrens Road, between Chief Street and Park Terrace / Fitzroy Terrace, will be closed from the **16 - 18 September 2021, between 7pm and midnight, weather permitting.**
- westbound lanes of Torrens Road, between Guthrie Street and the rail line, will be closed from the **16 - 18 September 2021, between midnight and 6am, weather permitting.**

Detours will be in place to direct motorists. Advanced notice signage will be in place prior to the closures. Further information about the detours will also be provided on the project website and social media pages.

Additional traffic changes, including lane and speed restrictions, will be in place along Torrens Road, Churchill Road, and intersecting side streets during the work.

Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained.
