

OVINGHAM LEVEL CROSSING REMOVAL PROJECT

Chief Street construction works

As part of the Ovingham Level Crossing Removal Project, the Chief Street junction with Torrens Road is being upgraded.

To upgrade the junction, the PTP Alliance needs to undertake pavement rehabilitation and line marking.

What to expect during works

Traffic changes

To safely facilitate these works, the following traffic detours will be in place:

- Access from Torrens Road to Chief Street will be closed, from 6am Saturday, 26 March until 5am Sunday, 27 March 2022 (weather permitting);
- detours will be in place for motorists and cyclists via West Street and Fifth Street; and
- temporary pedestrian detours will be in place around the works site and pedestrians are advised to follow directional signage. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Please note that motorists will still be able to turn left from Chief Street onto Torrens Road.

Access to local businesses and residences in the area will be maintained during these works. There is no change to public transport services.

Work hours

Pavement rehabilitation works will be undertaken between 6am and 6pm Saturday, 26 March 2022.

Chief Street is planned to reopen 5am Sunday, 27 March 2022, weather permitting.

Noise and vibration

Asphalt machinery, tippers, compaction equipment, grinders and trucks will be used during these works. Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise impacts to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

You may also notice some odor which is common when asphalting works are underway.
