

# WORKS NOTIFICATION

## OVINGHAM LEVEL CROSSING REMOVAL PROJECT

### North Adelaide Railway Station works

The Public Transport Projects Alliance (PTP Alliance) is removing the rail level crossing on Torrens Road, Ovingham to improve travel times, connectivity, and safety for all road and rail users. The \$196 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

As part of the Ovingham Level Crossing Removal project, the rail pedestrian crossing at North Adelaide Railway Station will be replaced with a new active pedestrian crossing at the same location.

The activation of the crossing will be completed in two stages. The first stage of work involves bringing into use the new pedestrian mazes and paths.

### What works are occurring?

The first stage of the rail pedestrian crossing works will include:

- removal of existing asphalt and placement of new asphalt along the crossing;
- concrete works for the new mazeways;
- placement of new tactiles; and
- installation of fencing and preparation for new mazeways.

### Timing of works

Works will be undertaken from Monday, 25 April 2022 until Monday, 9 May 2022, weather permitting.

The second stage of works involves activating the pedestrian crossing by installing automated safety gates, signals and upgraded signage. This is expected to take place later this year. Until that time, the crossing will operate as a passive crossing.

### What to expect during works

#### *Access changes*

To safely facilitate these works, the rail pedestrian crossing will need to be closed at times. Signage will be installed in advance at the crossing to advise of closure times and dates. Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to follow directional signage.

#### *Work hours*

Works will be undertaken Monday to Saturday, between 7am and 5pm. Advance notice will be provided should works be required on Sundays.

#### *Noise and vibration*

Asphalt machinery, concrete saws, tippers, compaction equipment, grinders and trucks will be used during these works. Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise impacts to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

You may also notice some odor which is common when asphaltting works are underway.
