NIGHT WORKS NOTIFICATION

CONTINUED UTILITY SERVICES RELOCATION WORKS

AUGUST – SEPTEMBER 2018

From **Saturday 18 August to mid September**, night works will continue for the installation of utility services, for SA Power Networks and SA Water. This includes conduit trenching and the relocation of a water main. Works will be undertaken within the rail corridor, on Diagonal and Morphett Roads and Murray Terrace, Oaklands Park.

The Oaklands Crossing Grade Separation Project will improve safety for all road users and ease traffic congestion by lowering the rail line under the road and removing the level crossing. The \$174.3 million project is jointly funded by the Australian Government (\$95 million), the South Australian Government (\$74.3 million) and the City of Marion (\$5 million), and will be delivered by the Public Transport Projects (PTP) Alliance with the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI).

Key Activities

Night works will continue to be undertaken within the rail corridor, on Diagonal and Morphett Roads and Murray Terrace, **from Saturday 18 August, between the hours of 7.00pm and 6.00am**. Respite nights will be provided throughout these works where possible. Please note that there will also be ongoing works during the day within the project zone.

Key activities throughout the various works include:

- Set up of heavy machinery (including excavators, vacuum trucks and crane trucks)
- Set up of traffic management and temporary lighting
- Trenching works for the relocation of a water main, cable installation and laying of conduits
- Pipework installation and connections
- Truck movement to transport materials and spoil
- Backfill, compaction and reinstatement of trenches.

How will these works affect me?

Night works are required to reduce impacts on traffic flow and the construction crew will make every effort to minimise noise and lighting impacts to nearby residents and businesses as much as possible.

To allow for relocation of the water main, traffic travelling southbound on Morphett Road will be reduced to one lane adjacent the construction zone. This will be in place from Thursday 16 August until mid September. This water main relocation is critical to the progress of the Morphett Road bridge build, and the project team will be undertaking works during the day as well as night. For three consecutive weekends from Friday 24 August, a crew will be working Friday evenings through until Monday mornings.

Please note that for any planned water outages, affected customers will be notified separately by SA Water.
