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## OAKLANDS CROSSING GRADE SEPARATION

### NIGHT WORKS AND TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS NOTIFICATION

#### JANUARY - FEBRUARY 2019

**Throughout January and February**, night works will continue on the Oaklands Crossing Grade Separation project. This work includes the installation of the station canopy, concreting works for retaining walls and station ramps, and the excavation of the rail corridor tunnel. The project will also continue to build the eastern side of the new Morphett Road bridge and begin installing throw screens on the western side of the bridge. Work activity will take place within the rail corridor, on Dunrobin, Morphett and Diagonal Roads and Murray and Crozier Terraces. Truck haulage activity will be in place in Addison Road, Struan Avenue, Crozier Terrace and Diagonal Way.

**A reminder to motorists that speed and lane restrictions will continue to be in place with traffic management located on site to advise commuters of changes to traffic conditions. Further information on traffic management is below.**

#### Key Activities

Night works will continue **between the hours of 7pm and 6am** and respite nights will be provided throughout these works where possible. **Please note that there will also be ongoing works during the day and construction crews will be utilising stockpile locations within the various project zones during the day and night. A temporary fenced compound will remain next to the rail corridor on Murray Terrace, near Barry Road.**

Key activities and impacts throughout the works include:

- Set up of heavy machinery, traffic management and temporary lighting
- Saw cutting and trenching of road surfaces to lay traffic signal and road lighting conduits, for the new intersection at Diagonal and Dunrobin Roads
- Hydro-vacuuming, backfilling, compaction and reinstatement of trenches
- SA Water main investigation works
- Concrete and steel works for the Morphett Road bridge
- Truck movement to transport materials and spoil to stockpile areas.


Numerous works within the rail corridor include:

- Station formation and service installation
- Soil nail, mesh, shotcrete and steel fixing
- Crane lifting, earthworks and excavation
- New signal cabling installation works.

#### How will these works affect me?

The construction crew will make every effort to minimise noise and lighting impacts to nearby residents and businesses as much as possible. As there will also be ongoing day works in these areas, where possible, the construction crew will aim to complete the most disruptive works during the day and early evening.

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For all works, speed and lane restrictions and closures will continue to be in place on main and local roads, with traffic management located on site to advise commuters of changed traffic conditions. Road users and pedestrians are advised to please take care and observe traffic signage when travelling through the area. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist. The project works closely with the Traffic Management Centre and where possible, works that may cause further traffic delays will be undertaken outside peak hours and during weekends.
