CLOSURE OF PEDESTRIAN/CYCLIST RAIL CROSSING From March 2019

During the early stages of project community consultation, the project team received feedback supporting the closure of the existing pedestrian/cyclist rail crossing that provides access between Murray and Crozier Terraces, near Carlton Street and Johnstone Road.

The new pedestrian and cyclist overpass bridge now open at the eastern end of the Oaklands Railway Station, will replace this crossing.

This new bridge access provides a safer passage across the rail crossing, in line with the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure's Railway Crossing Safety Strategy.

Works to remove the crossing will commence next month. The crossing will be closed from March, with final removal to be undertaken in mid-April.
