WORKS NOTIFICATION

DWYER ROAD RESERVE SITE COMPOUND SET UP AND TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

MONDAY 9 APRIL 2018

From Monday 16 April, the PTP Alliance will commence set up of the site compounds for the Oaklands Crossing Grade Separation project. The project's main compound will be on Dwyer Road reserve, with an additional small compound on Diagonal Way reserve. The compounds will be in place for up to 15 months and will house offices, amenities, staff car parking and material storage. A map of the site compounds is provided overleaf.

The Oaklands Crossing Grade Separation Project will improve safety for all road users and ease traffic congestion by lowering the rail line under the road and removing the level crossing. The project will be delivered by the Public Transport Projects (PTP) Alliance, with the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI), the Australian Government and the City of Marion.

Key Activities

During site set up, you may see the:

- Use of heavy machinery and increased traffic movement
- Installation of temporary fencing, site offices, amenities and temporary lighting
- Removal of playground equipment in Dwyer Road reserve (please see information below on future reinstatement of reserve and play area).

How will these works affect me?

To facilitate deliveries during site set up and throughout the project, there will be intermittent speed and car parking restrictions along Dwyer Road and Diagonal Way. To allow safe staff and vehicle movements between the compounds within the Dwyer Road and Diagonal Way Reserves, a section of Diagonal Way will be closed from mid-April, throughout project construction.

The compounds will be used for the duration of the project and we are committed to keeping construction impacts to a minimum where possible. We will work closely with the community to address any concerns or issues raised during construction.

What else do I need to know?

Please note that during site set up, SA Water will undertake some minor trenching within Diagonal Way to lay new sewer connections for the compounds. All trees in Dwyer Road reserve will be protected and we are working closely with the City of Marion to return the reserve and play area to the community following completion of the project. The City of Marion will consult with the community on a new neighbourhood playground and reserve upgrade in late 2018, with construction to commence in late 2019.
