NIGHT WORKS NOTIFICATION

UNDERGROUND CABLE RELOCATION WORKS

JUNE 2018

From **Wednesday 6 June 2018**, the project team will commence night works to install conduits (tubing to protect electrical wires), as well as inspect and relocate underground cables at various locations in Murray and Railway Terraces and Diagonal and Morphett Roads, Oaklands Park. This is in preparation for major construction works for the Oaklands Crossing Grade Separation project.

Please note that during the works on the nights of 15 June and 16 June there will be a partial, late night line closure between 10pm and 4am with substitute buses running between Adelaide and Brighton and trains between Brighton and Seaford. The Oaklands Crossing Grade Separation Project will improve safety for all road users and ease traffic congestion by lowering the rail line under the road and removing the level crossing. The \$174.3 million project is jointly funded by the Australian Government (\$95 million), the South Australian Government (\$74.3 million) and the City of Marion (\$5 million), and will be delivered by the Public Transport Projects (PTP) Alliance with the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI).

Key Activities

Night works will be undertaken in Murray and Railway Terraces to inspect cables, and in Diagonal and Morphett Roads to install conduits and relocate cables, on **Wednesday 6 June to Tuesday 12 June, and Thursday 14 June to Saturday 16 June, between the hours of 8.00pm and 6.00am.**

Key activities include:

- Set up of heavy machinery, traffic management and temporary lighting
- Lifting of cable pit lids to inspect and modify cables
- Trenching to install conduits and lay underground cables
- Backfill and reinstatement of trenches
- Truck movement to transport spoil.

How will these works affect me?

Night works are required to reduce impacts on traffic flow and the construction crew will make every effort to minimise noise and lighting impacts to nearby residents and businesses. *Please see map overleaf for work locations.*

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place during the works with traffic management located on site to advise commuters of changed traffic conditions. Road users and pedestrians are advised to please take care and observe traffic signage when travelling through the area. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist road users.
