NIGHT WORKS NOTIFICATION

BILLBOARD REMOVAL AND RAIL CORRIDOR WORKS

MAY 2018

In preparation for major construction works, the PTP Alliance will be removing two billboards next to Morphett Road, undertaking concrete piling works and relocating overhead wires and gantries within the rail corridor, from **Saturday 19 May 2018**.

Please note that during these works there will be a partial, late night line closure with substitute buses running between Adelaide and Brighton & trains between Brighton and Seaford, for further information please visit the Adelaide Metro website at www.adelaidemetro.com.au.

The Oaklands Crossing Grade Separation Project will improve safety for all road users and ease traffic congestion by lowering the rail line under the road and removing the level crossing. The \$174.3 million project is jointly funded by the Australian Government (\$95 million), the South Australian Government (\$74.3 million) and the City of Marion (\$5 million), and will be delivered by the Public Transport Projects (PTP) Alliance with the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI).

Key Activities

Works will be undertaken at night over two weekends **between the hours of 9.00pm and 5.00am on Saturday 19 May and Sunday 20 May, then Friday 25 May and Saturday 26 May**, weather permitting.

Key activities include:

- Set up of heavy machinery (including a crane), traffic management and temporary lighting
- Dismantling of billboards
- Truck movement to transport dismantled billboards
- Drilling and supporting of two piles in the rail corridor
- Concrete pouring and setting
- Relocation of overhead wires and gantries.

How will these works affect me?

Night works are required to minimise impacts on traffic flow and train services. The construction crew will make every effort to minimise noise and lighting impacts to nearby residents and businesses as much as possible. *Please see map overleaf for work locations.*

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place during the works with traffic management located on site to advise vehicles of changed traffic conditions. Pedestrian access changes and footpath closures will also be in place when in close proximity to the worksites. Road users and pedestrians are advised to please take care and observe traffic signs when travelling through the area. Traffic controllers will also be on site to assist road users.

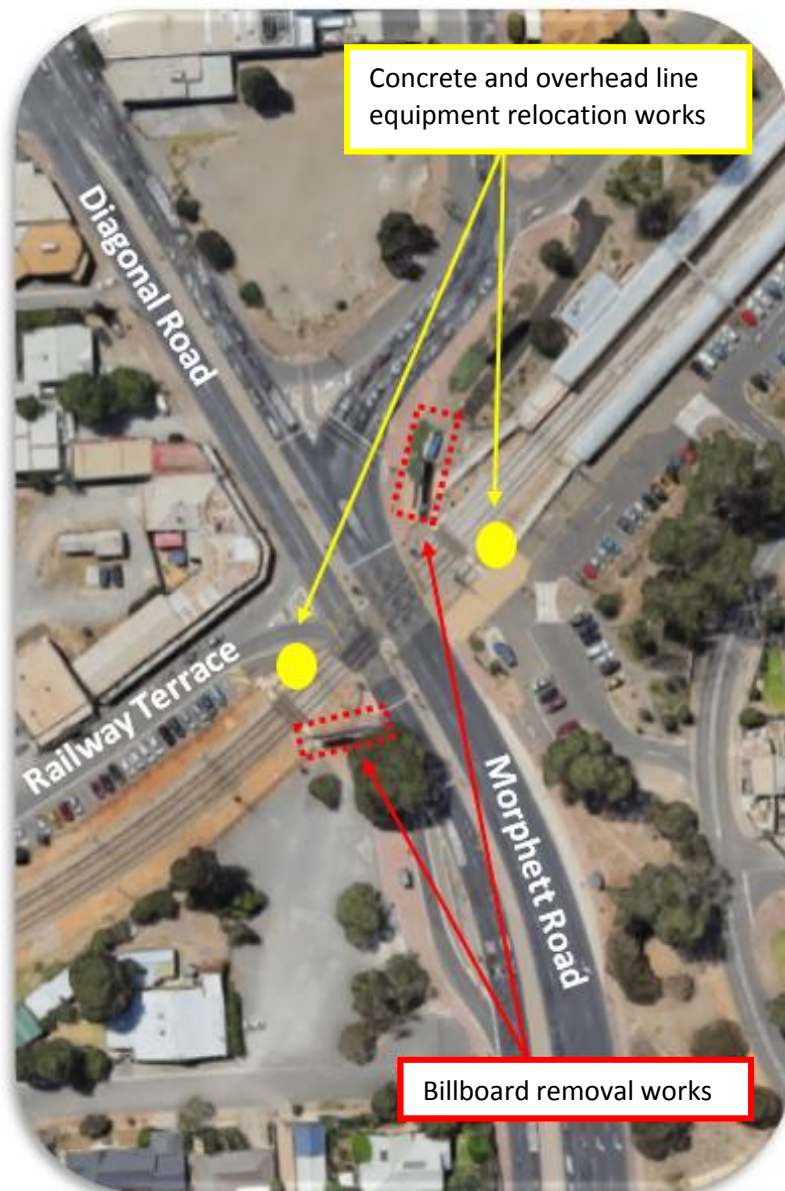
