

Oaklands Crossing Grade Separation Project – Early Investigation Works

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

As part of the Oaklands Crossing Grade Separation Project, additional early investigation works will be undertaken commencing **Wednesday 28 February 2018**, between the hours of 7am and 5pm (Monday to Saturday), weather permitting.

Works will involve site surveying, drilling to assess and determine existing underground services and excavation to test ground conditions, at various locations along the project alignment and surrounding roads. These works will assist in informing the early design phase.

Temporary short-term speed and lane restrictions will be in place when there are impacts to local roads, however roads will remain open to traffic at all times. Other restrictions may apply subject to onsite conditions.

These short-term traffic impacts, including those along Morphett or Diagonal roads, will apply from 2 March 2018 outside of peak hour traffic times.

Some noise can be expected while works are completed, however every effort will be made to minimise disturbance to local residents and businesses.

Signage will be in place to advise motorists of the changed traffic conditions. Road users are requested to take extra care when workers are in the area and observe traffic signage and speed restrictions.

The Oaklands Crossing Grade Separation Project will improve safety for all road users and ease traffic congestion by lowering the rail line under the road and removing the level crossing. The Public Transport Projects (PTP) Alliance, including partner organisations McConnell Dowell, Mott MacDonald and ARUP, have been selected to join with the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure to deliver this important project. Major works are planned to start mid-2018 with early preliminary works starting in April/May 2018.
