### NIGHT WORKS NOTIFICATION

#### UNDERGROUND CONDUIT, PILING AND SA WATER ASSET WORKS JUNE – JULY 2018

From **Sunday, 17 June to Friday, 6 July, 2018**, night works will continue in preparation for major bridge construction works, for the Oaklands Crossing Grade Separation project. This will include works to install conduits (tubing to protect electrical wires), as well as install piling (construction of vertical columns in the ground to provide extra support for the bridge) and investigate SA Water assets within Crozier Terrace and Diagonal and Morphett Roads, Oaklands Park.

The Oaklands Crossing Grade Separation Project will improve safety for all road users and ease traffic congestion by lowering the rail line under the road and removing the level crossing. The \$174.3 million project is jointly funded by the Australian Government (\$95 million), the South Australian Government (\$74.3 million) and the City of Marion (\$5 million), and will be delivered by the Public Transport Projects (PTP) Alliance with the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI).

#### Key Activities

Night works will be undertaken on Crozier Terrace and Diagonal and Morphett Roads, **from Sunday 17 June to Friday 6 July, between the hours of 7.00pm and 6.00am (work nights are Sunday to Friday)**. Please note that there will also be intermittent works during the day.

Key activities throughout the various works include:

- Set up of heavy machinery (including excavators, concrete trucks and a piling rig)
- Set up of traffic management and temporary lighting
- Trenching works to install conduits
- Trenching works to inspect existing, and install new SA Water assets (late June- early July)
- Installation of steel plates to protect underground services
- Backfill and reinstatement of trenches
- Piling works for the Morphett Road bridge (early July)
- Truck movement to transport spoil.

#### How will these works affect me?

Night works are required to reduce impacts on traffic flow and the construction crew will make every effort to minimise noise and lighting impacts to nearby residents and businesses. *Please see map overleaf for work locations.*

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place during the works with traffic management located on site to advise commuters of changed traffic conditions. Road users and pedestrians are advised to please take care and observe traffic signage when travelling through the area. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist road users.
