



EARLY WORKS NOTIFICATION

CONCRETE POUR

Wednesday, 6 May 2020

As part of the Paradise Park 'n' Ride Project, four large concrete pours are required to be undertaken. A third concrete deck pour is scheduled to be undertaken from **4 am to 6 pm on Wednesday, 6 May 2020**, weather permitting. Advance notice will also be provided for the last concrete pour when the date is known.

The concrete pours need to occur early in the morning when the weather is cooler. Rain, supply issues or construction changes could therefore bring these works either forward or back by a day or two.

During these works you may notice increased truck movements in the area. Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to local residents as much as practically possible. Temporary lighting will also be used.

To safely facilitate these works, Gameau Road will be restricted to one lane (city bound only) to accommodate the vehicle pumping the concrete. Passenger vehicles travelling along Gameau Road city bound will be restricted to 25km/h with vehicles travelling towards Darley Road required to temporarily detour via Norman Street, Woodmere Avenue and Inwood Avenue. Detour signage will be in place. There is no change to public transport services during the works.

The local two-hour parking will be temporarily removed along the detour route and traffic management will be on site to assist motorists and pedestrians. Signage will be in place to advise of the changed traffic conditions.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are in the area. Observe traffic signage, speed restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

COVID-19: An important message to our stakeholders

To continue to deliver these important infrastructure works and safeguard the workers and the community, we have implemented measures to manage our response to, and stop the spread of, COVID-19.

Measures include increased hygiene requirements and implementing social distancing protocols both on site and in the project offices.
