Dear Resident/Business Owner,

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) will begin early investigation works for the Port Dock Railway Line project on **Monday, 6 November 2017**.

Works are expected to take **approximately 3 weeks to complete**, weather permitting.

The works will typically be undertaken between the hours of **7am and 5pm Monday to Friday** and will involve locating underground services and drilling to sample and test the soil at various locations along the project alignment, between Grand Junction Road and Baker Street.

Some noise can be expected while works are completed, however every effort will be made to minimise disturbance to local residents and businesses.

The \$16.4 million South Australian Government funded Port Dock Railway Line project will include the re-construction and duplication of the spur line from the existing Outer Harbour line at Grand Junction Road and construction of a new railway station at Baker Street. Once complete, the project will link the Port's commercial centre and the Dock One residential precinct to the Adelaide CBD.

This project forms part of DPTI's Public Transport Program, and will be delivered through an Alliance Contract. This alliance is a program of key public transport capital initiatives announced in the 2017-18 State Budget.

The program of works, which also includes the Oaklands Crossing Project, the Klemzig and Tea Tree Plaza Park'n'Ride upgrades and the Mike Turtur bikeway at Goodwood, seeks to achieve a range of objectives relating to network optimisation, public transport patronage uplift and safety to be completed by June 2019.
